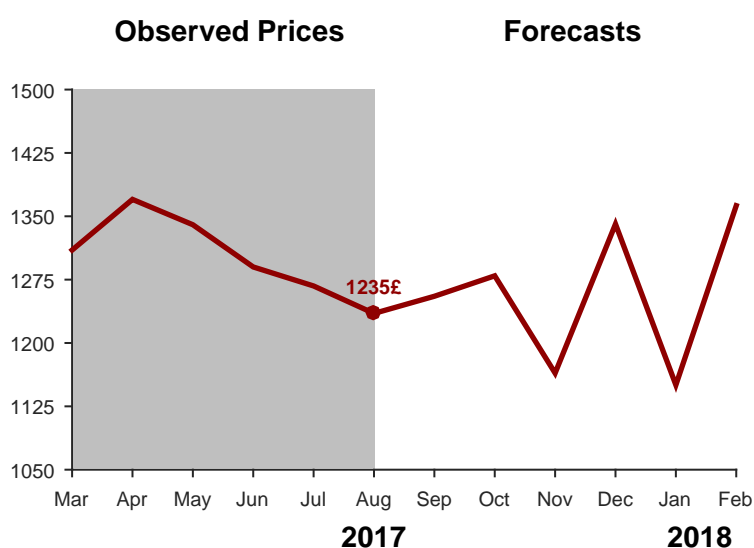

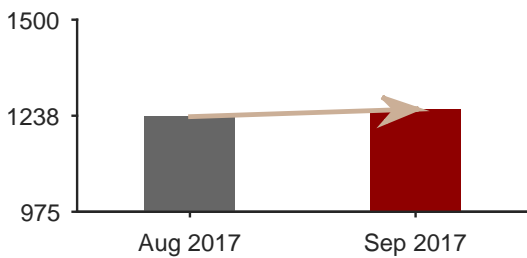

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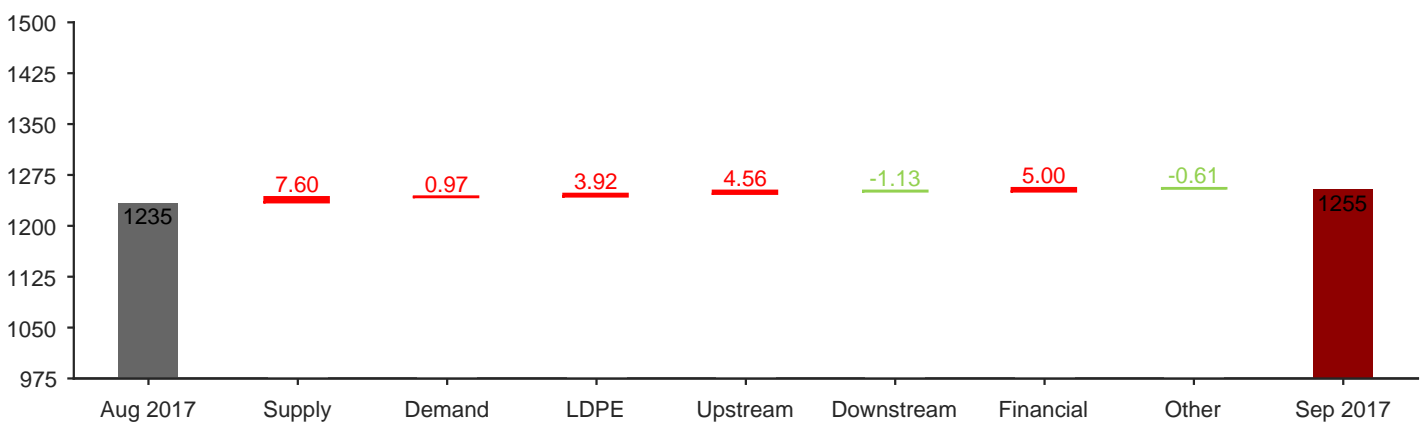
# Forecasting the Price of LDPE

## Impact Analysis: One Month Forecast



Our algorithm forecasts a higher price of LDPE in one month: it is expectable that the price increases 1.64% from 1235£ to 1255£ until the beginning of September.

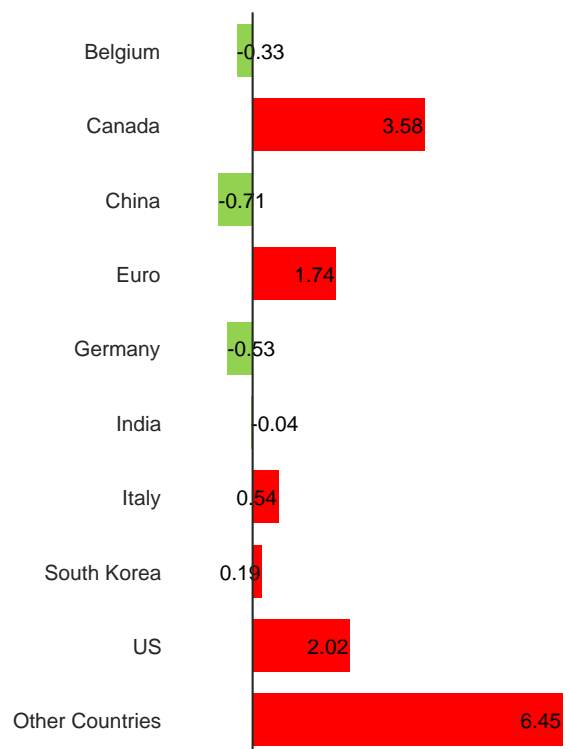
## Indices of Factors

- **Increase of Demand:** Positive pressure of the Demand index
- Positive pressure of the index of LDPE
- Positive pressure of the index of variables representing the market upstream

- Positive pressure of the financial index
- Slightly negative pressure of other commodities and other factors
- Focus on Canada, Qatar, and Japan

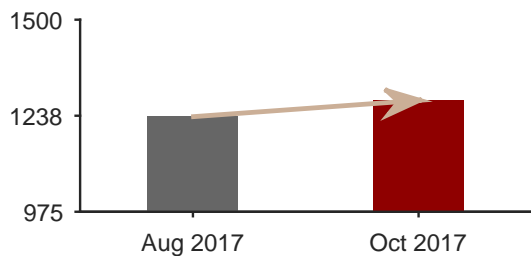

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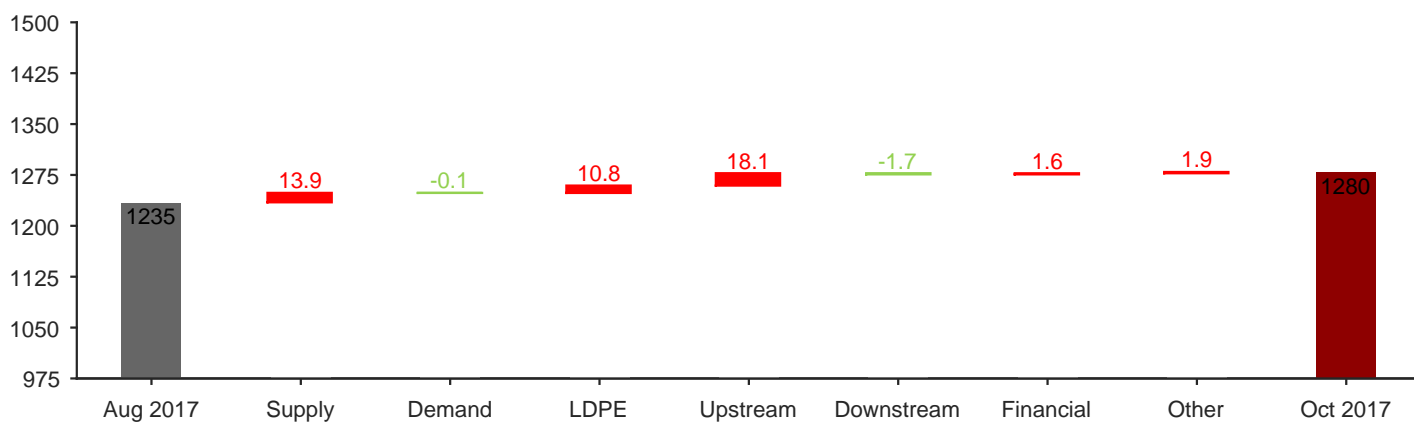
# Forecasting the Price of LDPE

## Impact Analysis: Two Months Forecast



Our algorithm forecasts a higher price of LDPE in two months: it is expectable that the price increases 3.60% from 1235£ to 1280£ until the beginning of October.

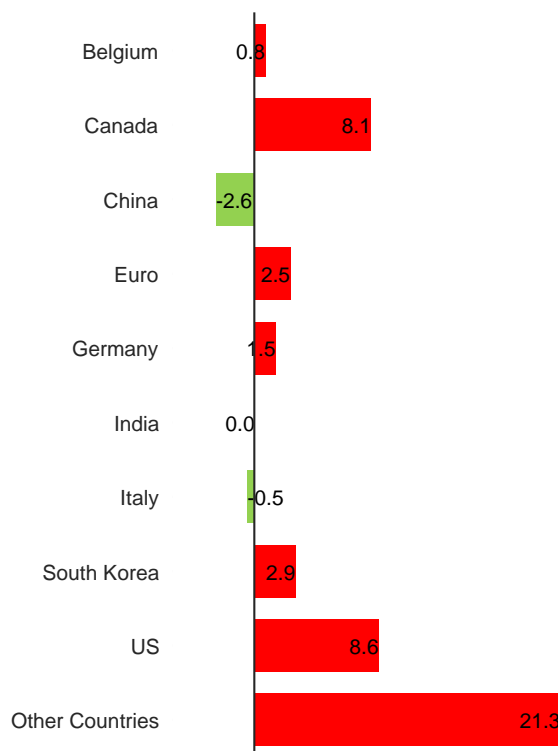

- Focus on US, Canada, and UK

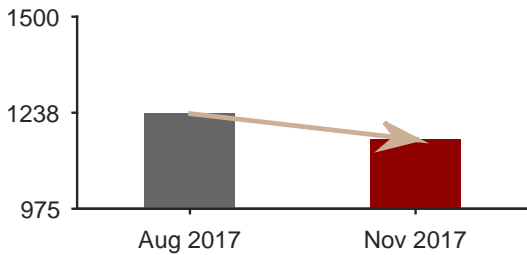

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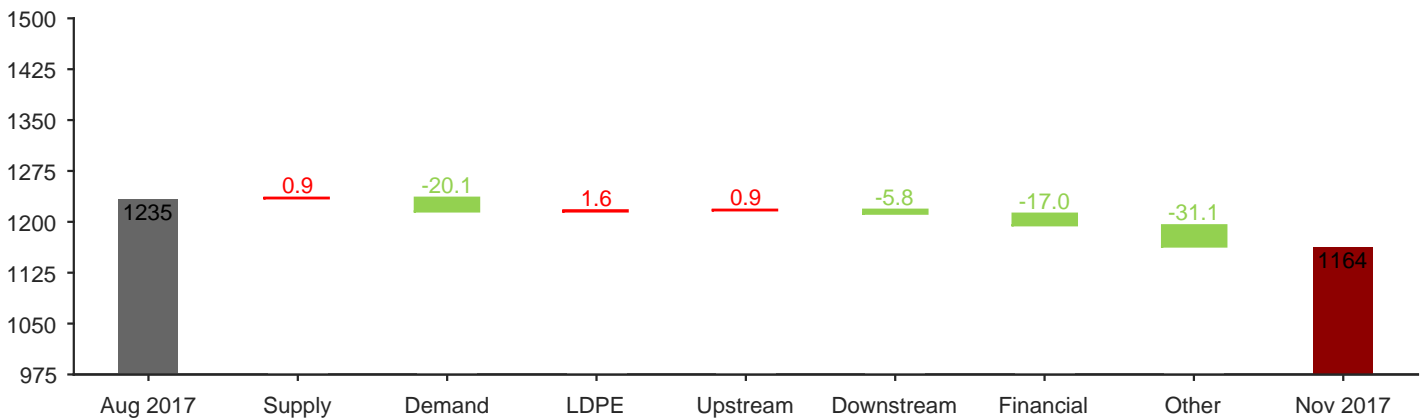
# Forecasting the Price of LDPE

## Impact Analysis: Three Months Forecast



Our algorithm forecasts a lower price of LDPE in three months: it is expectable that the price decreases 5.72% from 1235£ to 1164£ until the beginning of November.

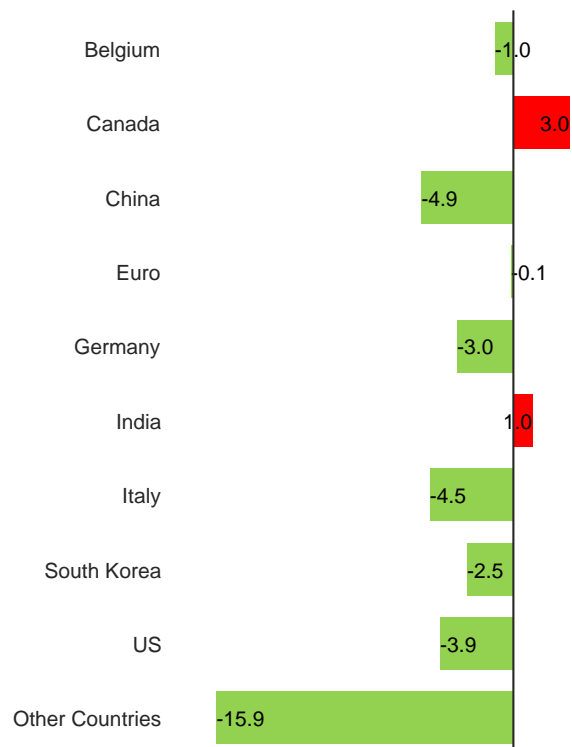

- Focus on UK, China, and Italy

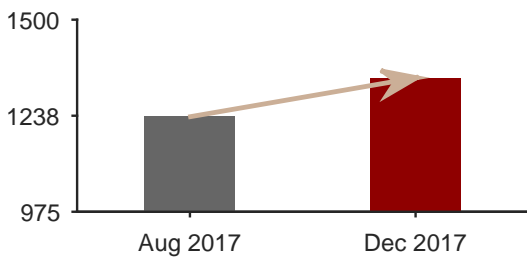

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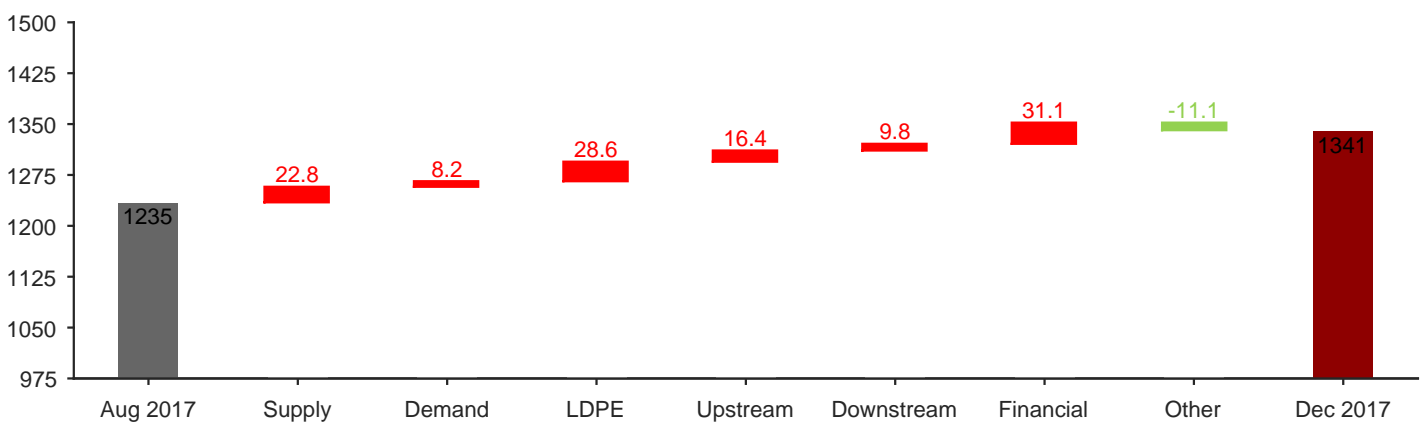
# Forecasting the Price of LDPE

Our algorithm forecasts a higher price of LDPE in four months: it is expectable that the price increases 8.56% from 1235£ to 1341£ until the beginning of December.

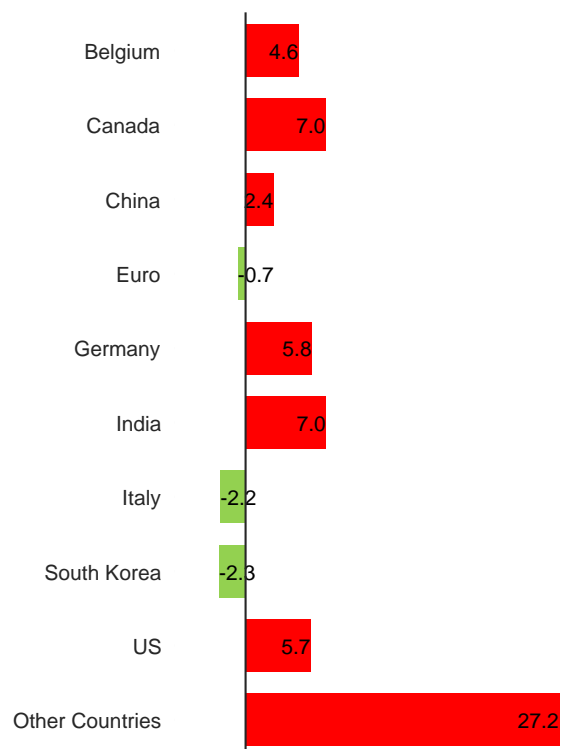

- Focus on UK, Mexico, and India

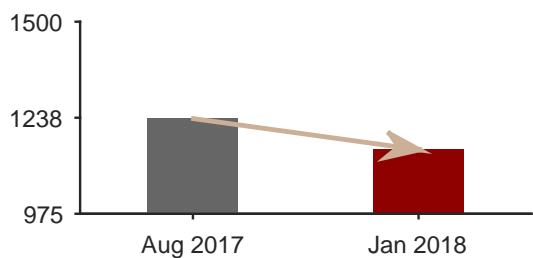

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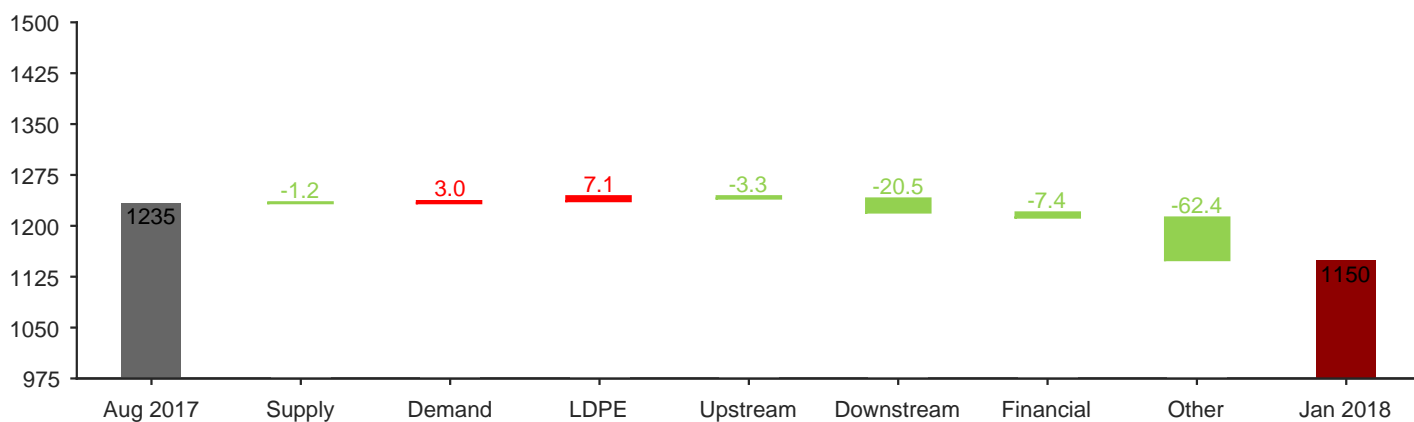
# Forecasting the Price of LDPE

## Impact Analysis: Five Months Forecast



Our algorithm forecasts a lower price of LDPE in five months: it is expectable that the price decreases 6.85% from 1235£ to 1150£ until the beginning of January.

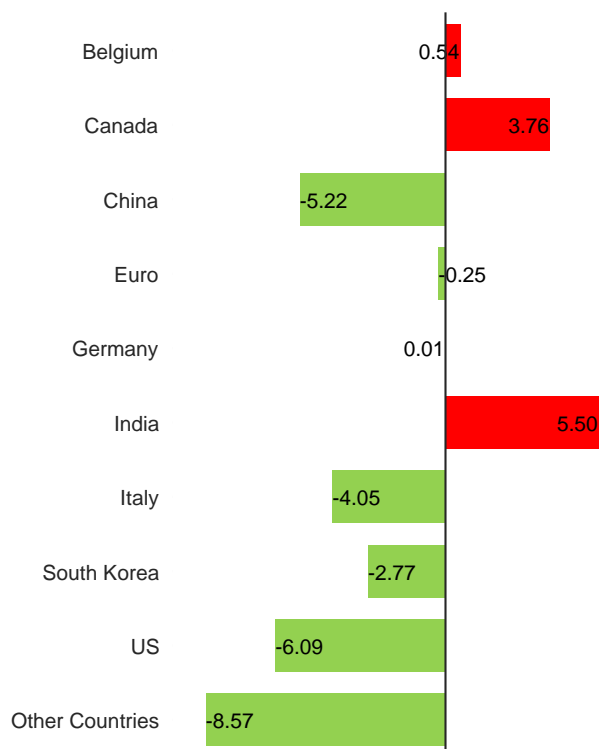
## Indices of Factors

- Slight increase of Supply: Negative pressure of the Supply index
- Slight increase of Demand: Positive pressure of the Demand index
- Positive pressure of the index of LDPE
- Slightly negative pressure of the index of variables representing the market upstream
- **Considerably negative pressure of the index of variables representing the market downstream**
- Negative pressure of the financial index
- **Considerably negative pressure of other commodities and other factors**
- Focus on Japan, US, and UK

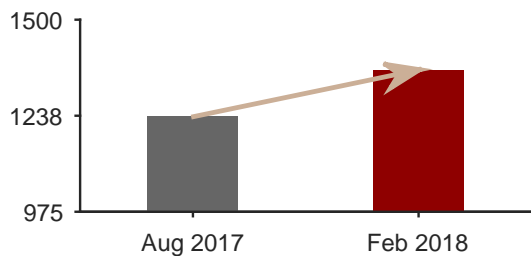

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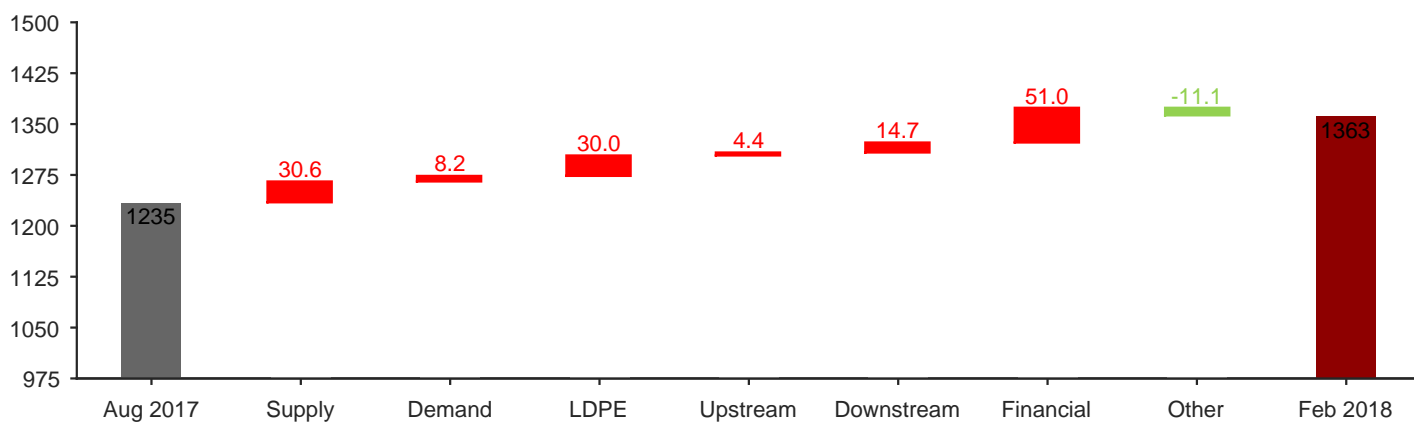
# Forecasting the Price of LDPE

## Impact Analysis: Six Months Forecast



Our algorithm forecasts a higher price of LDPE in six months: it is expectable that the price increases 10.32% from 1235£ to 1363£ until the beginning of February.

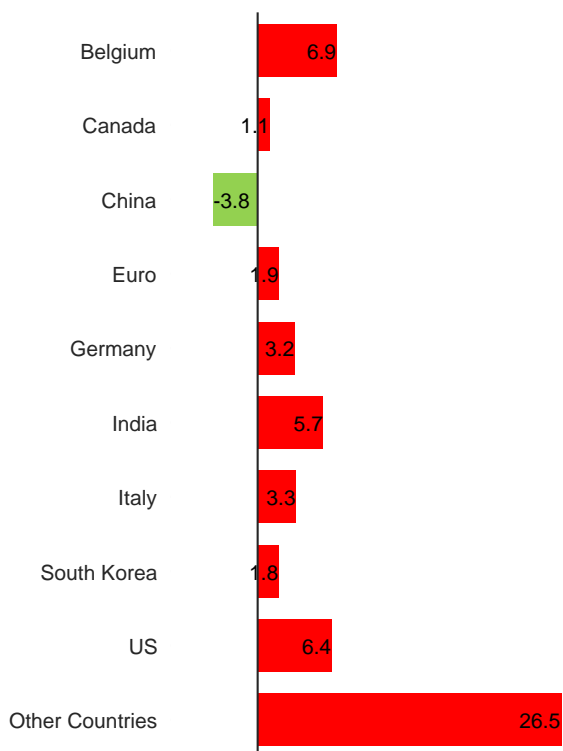
## Indices of Factors

- **Increase of Demand:** Positive pressure of the Demand index
- **Considerably positive pressure of the index of LDPE**
- Slightly positive pressure of the index of variables representing the market upstream

- **Considerably positive pressure of the financial index**
- Negative pressure of other commodities and other factors

## APPENDIX – Technical Explanation of the Impact Analysis

In this appendix, we explain the impact analysis of the factors that most contribute for our forecasts.

This Impact Analysis is conducted individually for **each time horizon**, allowing for a distinction between the indices of variables that contribute for our forecasts at short and medium run.

For each time horizon, our analysis has **two components**: first, we present the impact of variables grouped by **indices of factors**; second we present the impact of variables grouped by **indices of countries**.

### Indices of Factors

**Indices of factors** are indices of the weighted contributions of the variables grouped in those factors.

**Supply Index**: composed of macroeconomic variables of the producing and exporting countries. It includes variables such as production, exchange rates, inflation, monetary policy, and wages. For example, an increase in wages implies higher production costs which should (in linear, general, and ceteris paribus terms) generate an incentive to increase prices;

**Demand index**: composed of macroeconomic variables of the consuming and importing countries. It includes variables such as production, exchange rates, inflation, monetary policy, and wages. For example, a decrease in a consumer confidence index should (in linear, general, and ceteris paribus terms) increase savings and decrease demand, leading to lower prices;

**LDPE Index**: composed of variables related to LDPE. It includes variables such as the price of LDPE in different regions of the world and exports, imports, and producer prices of LDPE in some countries. For example, an increase in the price of LDPE in other region may imply an increase in the price of LDPE in Europe due to arbitrage movements;

**Upstream index**: composed of variables related to Ethylene, Ethane, Propane, and Natural Gas. It includes variables such as the price and exports, imports, and producer prices of the inputs in some countries. For example, an increase in the price of Ethylene should (in linear, general, and ceteris paribus terms) generate an increase in the price of LDPE;

## APPENDIX – Technical Explanation of the Impact Analysis (II)

**Downstream index:** composed of variables related to downstream industries, such as Packaging. It includes variables such as the exports, imports, and producer prices of the Plastic Industry in some countries. For example, an increase in the demand of Plastic should (in linear, general, and ceteris paribus terms) generate an increase in the price of LDPE;

**Financial Variables Index:** composed of financial market variables. It includes the share price of companies that produce LDPE. It also includes financial indices related to this sector. For example, a positive change in the share price of a producer of LDPE should (in linear, general, and ceteris paribus terms) imply an increase in expected profitability of the firm. This may signal an expectation of increase in the price of LDPE;

**Other Variables Index:** composed of variables related to other polymers and other commodities, such as Oil. It includes the price, exports, and imports of these commodities. For example, a positive change in the price of a substitute commodity, should (in linear, general, and ceteris paribus terms) imply an increase of demand of LDPE, and thus, of the price of LDPE.

## Indices of Countries

**Indices of Countries:** are indices of the weighted contributions of the macroeconomic variables of each country. The countries we present are the most relevant countries in the production, consumption, and international commerce of LDPE.

## Interpretation Warning

It is important to note that the contribution of individual variables and indices of variables is not linear. The interaction between variables and between variables of different factors may not be neglectable, which means that the importance of each variable and indices of variables is determined together with the importance of all other variables.

Furthermore, the analysis of changes in variables is not linear. This means that the same variable with the same change in different moments of time may have different impacts given its previous evolution. For example, the algorithm contrasts the change in a variable with its expected change. A positive change but inferior to the expected change may originate an effect of price correction.
